Pre-Apprenticeship & Digital Fabrication Camp



This camp will focus on manufacturing and digital fabrication. The Industrial Manufacturing Technician (IMT) Pre-Apprenticeship program will be incorporated into the camp experience. Students will apply their skills from this program using the "Skill Boss," a computer-controlled machine that provides hands-on experiences and real-world applications. Camp participants who complete the Pre-Apprenticeship program and pass an exam will earn an industry recognized credential.

Participants will also receive training in digital fabrication using stationary and mobile Fab Labs. Students will use computer-aided design software to complete a variety of hands-on fabrication projects involving a large CNC router, known as the ShopBot, a vinyl cutter, a laser engraver, electronics work bench, and a 3D printer. Students will also participate in a tour of a manufacturing facility and career readiness presentations as camp activities.

Transportation will be provided to and from the camp each scheduled day. Students will receive a t-shirt for participating in the camp. Daily snacks will be provided. A Student Showcase will take place on the final day of camp in which the participants will share their projects with their families, community agencies, and local businesses.
