TELL A TRUE STORY

Be honest. Share personal details with the reader. Relate fully to what story you're telling.

FULLY ANSWER THE QUESTION

Is the prompt a one or two part question? Address all portions and give complete answers.

WATCH THE WORD COUNT

Do not exceed the specified word count. Use available space to impress judges.

PROOFREAD & SHARE

Carefully and mindfully read over your essay. Find a trusted friend to proofread and critique.
